

Børresen Acoustics X3

LOUDSPEAKERFLOORSTANDING LOUDSPEAKER



he Børresen X3 three-way, fourdriver floorstanding loudspeaker is a Danish-made design offering remarkable value given its highend audiophile credentials. It stands nearly 1.3m tall, taller than many similarly priced speakers from significant competitors. The X3 features a closed ribbon tweeter and distinctive 'spread-tow' carbon fibre mid and bass drivers, also found in Børresen's flagship M-series models. These drivers have sandwich cones with an aramid honeycomb filler between two carbon fibre skins, making them light and stiff. They also sport double copper caps on the pole pieces of the drivers to increase flux and reduce inductance. Its crossover is built with components found in Børresen's higherend Z series, ensuring mechanical stability and minimal self-resonance. The cabinet is made of a heavily braced wood composite material, reinforced with carbon fibre on the top and front, and finished in high gloss black or white. It sports six metal reflex ports on the rear baffle, and the cabinet sits on Ansuz anti-resonance feet.

Precise imaging

We felt that the Børresen X3s excel in reproducing powerful bass and precise imaging in our listening test. Their slimline baffle allows the X3s to disappear into the soundscape. They offer clean sound with quiet backgrounds and reveal fine details in recordings. Adding Darkz feet further enhances bass tightness and low-level resolution. Overall, the Børresen X3s provide excellent sound and build quality value, making them a worthwhile investment for audiophiles.
